THE EXODUS READING PLAN

DIVING INTO OLD TESTAMENT HISTORY

The book of Exodus is one of the most foundational narratives in the Bible, telling the story of God's deliverance, guidance, and covenant with his people. It is a book about freedom, faith, and obedience, showing how God rescues his people and leads them into a new way of life.

- Through Exodus, we learn that God is a deliverer, freeing the Israelites from slavery just as he delivers us from sin and hardships.
- Through Exodus, we learn that faith requires trust, as the Israelites struggled to rely on God even after witnessing miracles.
- Through Exodus, we see that God always provides and offers guidance, offering his people everything they need, from manna in the wilderness to the Ten Commandments.

Ultimately, Exodus reminds us that obedience leads to blessing, as God's laws were given not to restrict his people but to lead them toward a fulfilled and righteous life.

DAYS 1–12 | EXODUS 1–15 THE DELIVERANCE OF ISRAEL

*Follow the story of God rescuing
the Israelites from slavery in Egypt.*

DAY 1: Exodus 1 | *Israel's oppression in Egypt*

Cross Reference: Genesis 15:13–14; Acts 7:17–19

Reflect: How can faith endure during times of suffering?

DAY 2: Exodus 2 | *The birth of Moses and his flight to Midian*

Cross Reference: Acts 7:20–29; Hebrews 11:23–27

Reflect: How does God prepare people for his purpose?

DAY 3: Exodus 3:1–12 | *God calls Moses from the burning bush*

Cross Reference: Isaiah 6:8; Acts 7:30–34

Reflect: What is God calling you to do, even if you feel unworthy?

DAY 4: Exodus 3:13–22 | *God reveals his name, “I AM”*

Cross Reference: John 8:58; Revelation 1:8

Reflect: How does God’s eternal nature bring comfort?

DAY 5: Exodus 4:1–17 | *God equips Moses for his mission*

Cross Reference: Jeremiah 1:6–9; 2 Corinthians 12:9–10

Reflect: How does God strengthen you in moments of doubt?

DAY 6: Exodus 4:18–31 | *Moses returns to Egypt*

Cross Reference: Matthew 10:19–20; Hebrews 11:24–26

Reflect: What does obedience to God look like in your life?

DAY 7: Exodus 5:1–21 | *Pharaoh increases the Israelites’ burdens.*

Cross Reference: 2 Corinthians 4:8–9; James 1:2–4

Reflect: How can you trust God when circumstances worsen before they improve?

DAY 8: Exodus 6:1–13 | *God reassures Moses of his covenant*

Cross Reference: Genesis 17:7–8; Deuteronomy 7:9

Reflect: How does God’s faithfulness encourage perseverance?

DAY 9: Exodus 7:1–13 | *Moses and Aaron perform signs before Pharaoh*

Cross Reference: Acts 13:8–11; 2 Timothy 3:8–9

Reflect: How does God’s power surpass human resistance?

DAY 10: Exodus 7:14–24 | *The first plague: water turned to blood*

Cross Reference: Psalm 78:44; Revelation 16:3–6

Reflect: How does God reveal his power over creation?

DAY 11: Exodus 8 | *The plagues of frogs, gnats, and flies*

Cross Reference: Psalm 105:30–31; Revelation 16:13

Reflect: How does God show his authority over false gods?

DAY 12: Exodus 9 | *The plagues of livestock, boils, and hail*

Cross Reference: Exodus 15:11; Revelation 16:2

Reflect: How do these plagues demonstrate God's justice and mercy?

DAYS 13–20 | EXODUS 10–19
THE EXODUS AND THE WILDERNESS JOURNEY

*Experience Israel's miraculous deliverance
and their journey to Mount Sinai.*

DAY 13: Exodus 10 | *The plagues of locusts and darkness*

Cross Reference: Joel 2:25; Revelation 9:2–3

Reflect: How does God patiently give opportunities to turn back to him?

DAY 14: Exodus 11 | *The final plague foretold: the death of the firstborn*

Cross Reference: Exodus 4:22–23; Hebrews 11:28

Reflect: How does God's judgment bring deliverance for his people?

DAY 15: Exodus 12:1–30 | *The first Passover and the final plague*

Cross Reference: John 1:29; 1 Corinthians 5:7

Reflect: How does the Passover foreshadow Jesus's sacrifice?

DAY 16: Exodus 12:31–51 | *The Exodus begins*

Cross Reference: Genesis 15:13–14; Numbers 33:3–4

Reflect: How does God fulfill his promises at the perfect time?

DAY 17: Exodus 13 | *God leads Israel with a pillar of cloud and fire*

Cross Reference: Nehemiah 9:12; Psalm 78:14

Reflect: How do you see God's guidance in your own life?

DAY 18: Exodus 14 | *The parting of the Red Sea*

Cross Reference: Isaiah 43:16–17; 1 Corinthians 10:1–2

Reflect: How does God make a way where there seems to be none?

DAY 19: Exodus 15:1–21 | *The song of Moses and Miriam*

Cross Reference: Psalm 105:1–2; Revelation 15:3

Reflect: How can you celebrate God's victories in your life?

DAY 20: Exodus 15:22–27 | *God provides water at Marah*

Cross Reference: Numbers 20:11; John 4:14

Reflect: How does God meet your needs in difficult times?

DAYS 21–30 | EXODUS 16–40
COVENANT AND WORSHIP AT MOUNT SINAI

Focus on God's covenant, laws, and instructions for worship.

DAY 21: Exodus 16 | *God provides manna and quail*

Cross Reference: Deuteronomy 8:3; John 6:31–35

Reflect: How do you depend on God for daily provision?

DAY 22: Exodus 17 | *Water from the rock and victory over Amalek*

Cross Reference: Deuteronomy 25:17–19; 1 Corinthians 10:3–4

Reflect: How does God strengthen you in battles of faith?

DAY 23: Exodus 18 | *Jethro advises Moses*

Cross Reference: Proverbs 11:14; Acts 6:2–4

Reflect: How can wisdom from others lighten your burdens?

DAY 24: Exodus 19 | *Israel meets God at Mount Sinai*

Cross Reference: Deuteronomy 4:10–12; Hebrews 12:18–21

Reflect: How do you prepare your heart to encounter God?

DAY 25: Exodus 20:1–21 | *The Ten Commandments*

Cross Reference: Matthew 22:37–40; Romans 13:8–10

Reflect: How do these commands shape your relationship with God and others?

DAY 26: Exodus 24 | *The covenant confirmed*

Cross Reference: Matthew 26:28; Hebrews 9:18–22

Reflect: How does God invite you into a covenant relationship with him?

DAY 27: Exodus 25:1–22 | *Instructions for the Ark of the Covenant*

Cross Reference: Hebrews 9:3–5; Revelation 11:19

Reflect: How does worship draw you closer to God's presence?

DAY 28: Exodus 32 | *The golden calf and Moses' intercession*

Cross Reference: Deuteronomy 9:16–19; 1 John 2:1

Reflect: How do you respond when others lose sight of God?

DAY 29: Exodus 33 | *Moses seeks God's presence and glory*


Cross Reference: Psalm 27:8; 2 Corinthians 3:18
